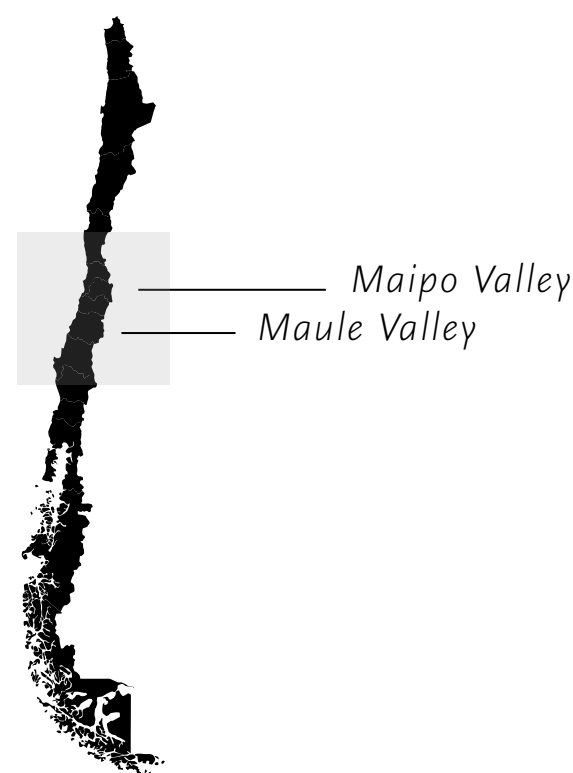

Crafted from small batches and aged in 500 liter French oak barrels, our intent is to capture the acidity and liveliness in this structured full-bodied blend.

Valleys.

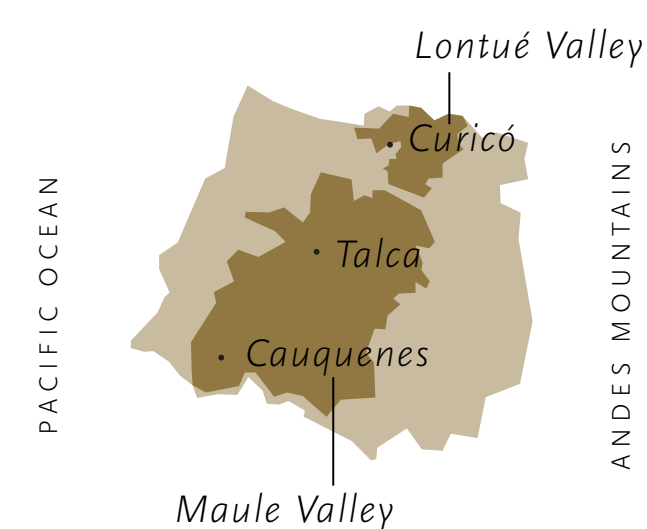

The 2018 season was exceptional in terms of performance and quality. There was a rain-free spring with good temperatures and conditions that allowed for the slow ripening of the grapes for superb development. Harvested with excellent maturity, wines showed great freshness, volume and structure in the mouth.

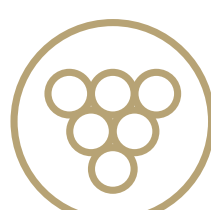

Tasting Notes

Concentrated deep violet in color, the nose is attractive and intense with aromas including hazelnuts, dates, and dried figs, as well as notes of jasmine and roses. The palate is sophisticated, intense, and juicy complemented by chocolate, coffee, and tobacco leaves. The finish is long with ripe and velvety tannins for an unforgettable experience.
