#### Why It's of Note

*The Norwegian Odfjell family founded this winery 25 years ago. This Cabernet comes from the Maipo Valley, which is the hottest region of Chile's Central Valley. It also has a lot of history: This is where Bordeaux varieties were first planted in Chile.*
