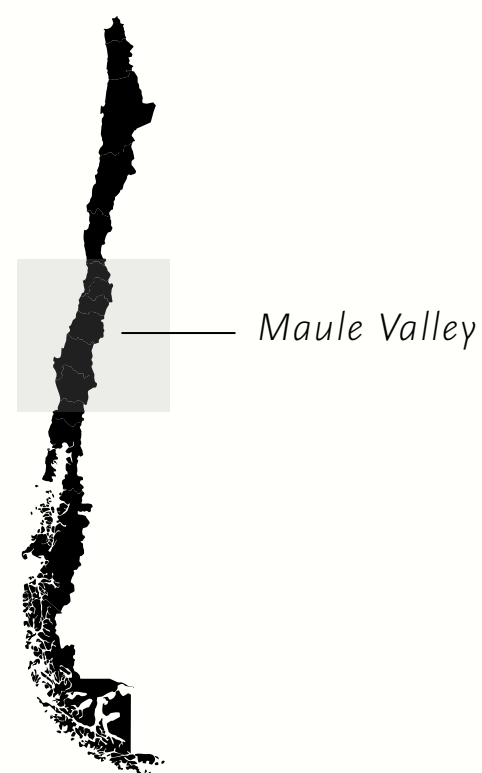

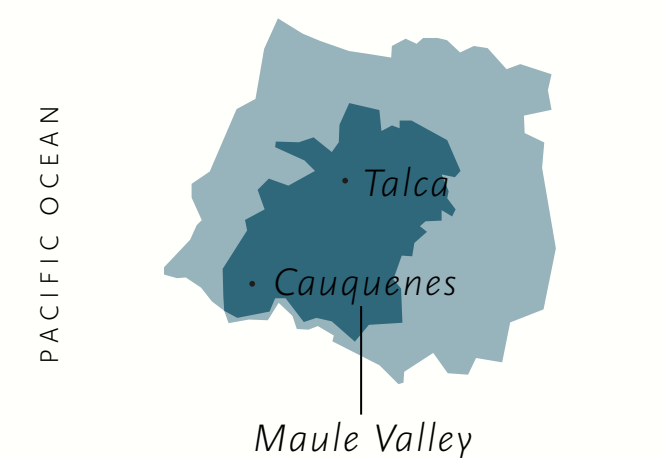

The Vintage

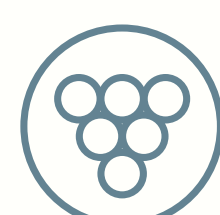
The Maule Valley was affected by a decrease in rainfall and average temperatures reached higher numbers than previous seasons. However, the quality of the grapes was exceptional, giving wines with great balance between volume, freshness and acidity.

Winemaking & Aging

- 12 to 14 months
- 100% stainless steel tanks
- Native yeasts
- Production: 3,300 9L cases
- Cellaring recommendation: 6-8 years

Tasting Notes

Deep and intense ruby color with a touch of violet. This wine displays a never ending mix of aromas such as cherry liqueur, liquorice, white fruit such as apricots, white peaches, pears and a touch of lychee. A note of jasmine to conclude a refreshing experience.



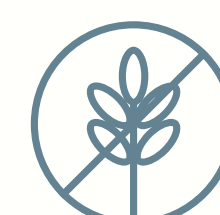
