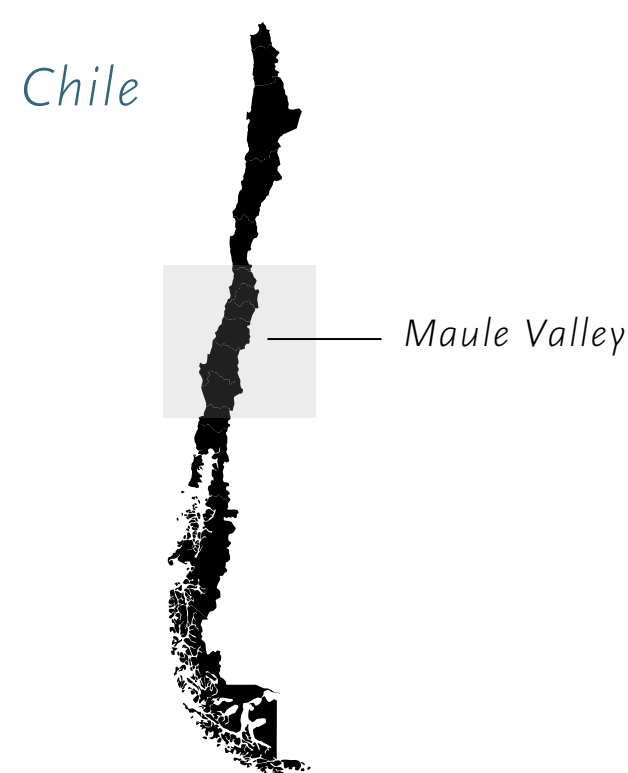


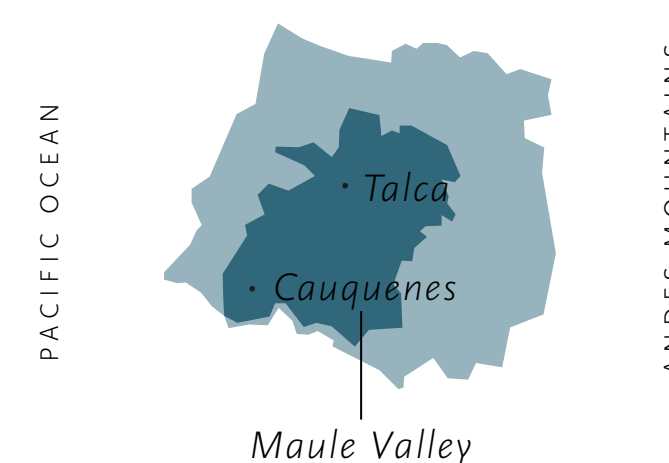

The Maule Valley was affected by lower rainfall and temperatures were higher than in previous seasons. However, the quality of the grapes was exceptional, producing wines with great balance between volume, freshness and acidity.

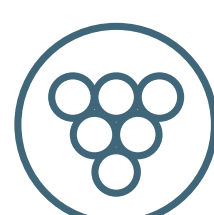

Tasting Notes

Complex and profound nose with black fruits, spices and violets. The palate is full and juicy with silky and fresh tannins. It is long and persistent with a finish where the black fruit reappears.
